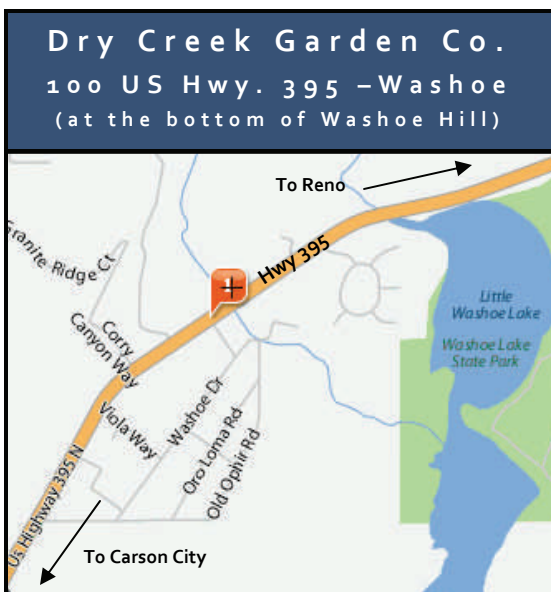
A “Hands On” Renewable
